Day Aggregates' eco-site reprocesses 350,000 tonnes of construction and demolition (C&D) waste every year.

Background

A division of Day Group, Day Aggregates is a supplier of aggregates for the construction and landscaping industries.

They handle nearly three million tonnes of construction material each year.

Day Aggregates first conceived a reprocessing facility for C&D waste in 1998. A basic plant was functional by 1999, sited on brownfield land on a safeguarded wharf in Charlton, Greenwich.

What happened

In 2000, Day Aggregates discussed with London Remade the opportunities for reprocessing C&D waste.

They won London Remade's competitive tender in 2001 to build a C&D reprocessing facility.

As delivery agent for the London Development Agency's Single Regeneration Budget, London Remade contributed a capital grant of £296,000 towards the

development of a C&D reprocessing facility – the first of its kind in the UK.

London Remade has been developing the market for recycled materials since 2001.

The construction industry has become receptive to this. Day Aggregates produce all their recycled aggregates within the guidelines set out by the Quality Control Protocol for Recycled Aggregates.

Achievements

The eco-site was opened in March 2003 by Brian Wilson MP, Minister for Construction and Energy.

It has the capacity to handle 1,500 tonnes of C&D waste every day and helped create 95 new jobs. The reprocessed material is used for concrete production. Materials are transported sustainably along the River Thames.
